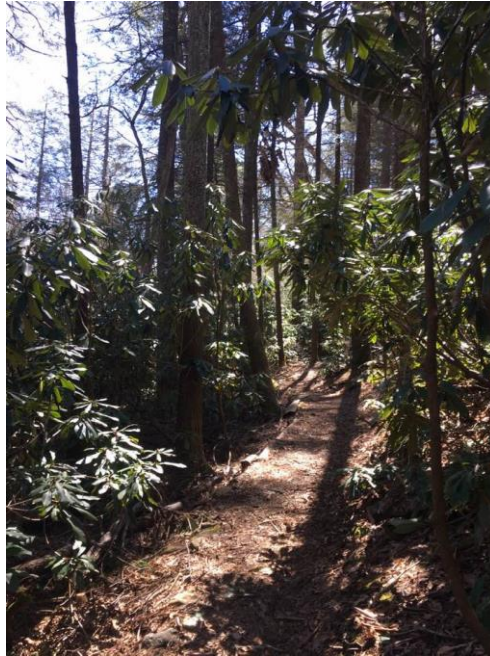




Highlands-Cashiers Land Trust Property: Brushy Face Preserve

Brushy Face Preserve is an entirely volunteer-built trail on the outskirts of Highlands, NC. There are about 2 miles of moderate trails including two loop trails. The trail head is located at a cul-de-sac with parking spots, and extends through old growth forests, and crosses over Clear Creek.



Directions to Brushy Face Preserve:

From Highlands, NC:

From downtown Highlands, NC follow 4th Street towards Wallhala. This becomes US 28. After about 1.5 miles, you will pass Rhodes Auto Care on your right, and Brushy Face Road will be your second right. After turning onto Brushy Face Road, turn left on to Old Pine Road. When you come to the end of Old Pine, turn left onto Pineland road. From there, there are parking areas along that cul-de-sac. The trailhead is at the farthest end of the cul-de-sac. **(About 2.5 miles total).**

From Cashiers, NC:

Head towards Highlands, NC on US64 West. Continue straight onto South 4th Street. See above directions from Highlands, NC. **(About 12.8 miles total).**
